# Teacher Resource

# Nom:

It is not necessary to utilize this teacher resource for this task. It is, however, recommended that teachers engage in a conversation about stereotyping. The answers provided in this resource are authentic and could be helpful for students because it provides them with examples of real people. The purpose of this listing task is to have students think about their biases and prejudices about people based on appearances. Ask students why they came up with the list they did and use their reasoning as a source for discussions. Students could also be prompted to discuss the nature of preferences. For example, although Person #5 prefers Black Metal and Rock, does this mean that he is not open to other genres of music? Does this mean that all people who look like him would prefer the same type of music and movies as he does? Although it may be true that people within a certain group have things in common with each other, does this mean that every single person in a group has the exact same preferences? Does it mean they all hold the same values? It can become very easy to use generalizations based on previous experiences to interpret new stimuli and if unchallenged can lead to unproductive stereotypes. It is important for the teacher to facilitate discussions to highlight that just because something may be common to a group of people, this does not mean that all people within that group prescribe to/ fit that generalization.

# Person #1
